

ARE YOU ON MEDICARE AND PAYING TOO MUCH FOR YOUR PRESCRIPTION MEDICATIONS?

You may be eligible for assistance with their Medicare prescription drug plan!

Income: Social Security, Pension, Unemployment, etc. **before deductions**. **Resources**: checking, savings, CDs, IRAs, and property (Does not include your home, the land it sits on, and one car).

Medicare Part D Extra Help: (2024 Guidelines)

This is available to all on Medicare with limited income and resources. Will help lower premium, deductible, drug costs and will eliminate coverage gap (donut hole).

<u>Income Limits</u>		Resources
Single	\$1,903/month	<i>Up to \$17,220</i>
Couple	<i>\$2,575/month</i>	<i>Up to \$34,360</i>

Medicare Savings Program:

The state will pay your Medicare Part B premium; it will no longer be deducted from your SS check, and includes Part D Extra Help.

Income Limits		Resources
Single	\$1,715/month	<i>Up to \$10,930</i>
Couple	<i>\$2,320/month</i>	<i>Up to \$17,130</i>

Medicaid:

Provides you with health insurance coverage pays your Medicare Part B premium (\$174.70), includes Part D Extra Help.

Income Limits		Resources
Single	\$1,275/month	<i>Up to \$2,000</i>
Couple	\$1,724/month	Up to \$3,000
