

PROCLAMATION OF A COUNTY STATE OF EMERGENCY



CASWELL COUNTY EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN

1. Pursuant to the Caswell County State of Emergency Ordinance and Chapter 166A of the North Carolina General Statutes and Article 36A, Chapter 14 of the North Carolina General Statutes, I have determined that a State of Emergency as defined in the Caswell County State of Emergency Ordinance exists in the County of Caswell because the potential of wide spread damage from Winter Storm Diego
2. I, therefore, proclaim the existence of a State of Emergency in the County of Caswell, NC to include the Town of Yanceyville and the Town of Milton.
3. I hereby order all county law enforcement officers, county employees and all other Emergency Management personnel subject to my control to cooperate in the enforcement and implementation of provisions of the County Emergency Ordinance which are set forth below.
4. I hereby order this proclamation to be distributed to the news media and other organizations calculated to bring its contents to the attention of the general public and to be distributed to others as necessary to assure proper implementation of this proclamation.
5. This proclamation shall become effective at 0800 (am) on December 9, 2018 and shall stay in effect until December 14, 2018 at 0800 (am) or until rescinded in writing.
